BULK PICKUP- Either one (1) 30-gallon container **OR** one (1) large bulk item i.e. refrigerator, couch, washer/dryer will be picked up curbside weekly with your regular garbage. **Refrigerators, air conditioners, washers & dryers, may take up to one week to be picked up.**
